


















Let's make things bright & breezy



CARE Place your broom in a light and sunny spot which is not too warm to ensure maximum blooming, and water regularly to prevent the leaves and flowers from becoming too dry

CARE All this plants needs is a light spot, some water and to have wilted flowers removed

This happy house plant not only has an optimistic appearance, it's also easy to care for.

With its big heart-shaped leaves that climb or dangle on long tendrils, sturdy scindapsus has many different guises.


> CARE Scindapsus needs a light, warm spot and regular watering with tepid water. It also appreciates being misted frequently








This uncomplicated flower looks like a child's drawing. The ox-eye daisy, also known as Leucanthemum, has a generous yellow heart surrounded by a crown of white petals. Her naive shape brings uplifting dots of joy to every Bright & Breezy bouquet.







Milkweed has rather coarse stems that contrast vigorously with the delicate sculpted umbels.

CARE This plant is very fond of sunlight. Add just a little bit of water and your yarrow will shine for days







There is something pleasantly cheeky about the allium. This flower globe consists of an infinite number of tiny flowers, and it dries beautifully. Give it space and the allium will shine.

CARE Place in a thoroughly cleaned vase, and replace the water every three days to enjoy your allium for as long as possible

Colour plays a key role in our **Bright & Breezy** trend, so the bright violet sage is absolutely essential.



CARE Place sage in the sun and out of the wind, and water it on hot days. It looks great in a border or in a pot with room to grow

CARE Give your garden ferns plenty of water and keep them out of the wind to enjoy the stunning leaves as long as possible





A decorative giant amongst low-growing bloomers. You can recognise the beautiful hosta by the sizable rosettes of leaves from which purple or lilac flower stems emerge. Many varieties also have leaves with attractive markings in faded colours from dark green, to white, to an absolutely gorgeous greyish green.

CARE Sun or shade will do fine. Keep the soil damp and give the plant some fertiliser in spring to enable the carefree enjoyment to begin
